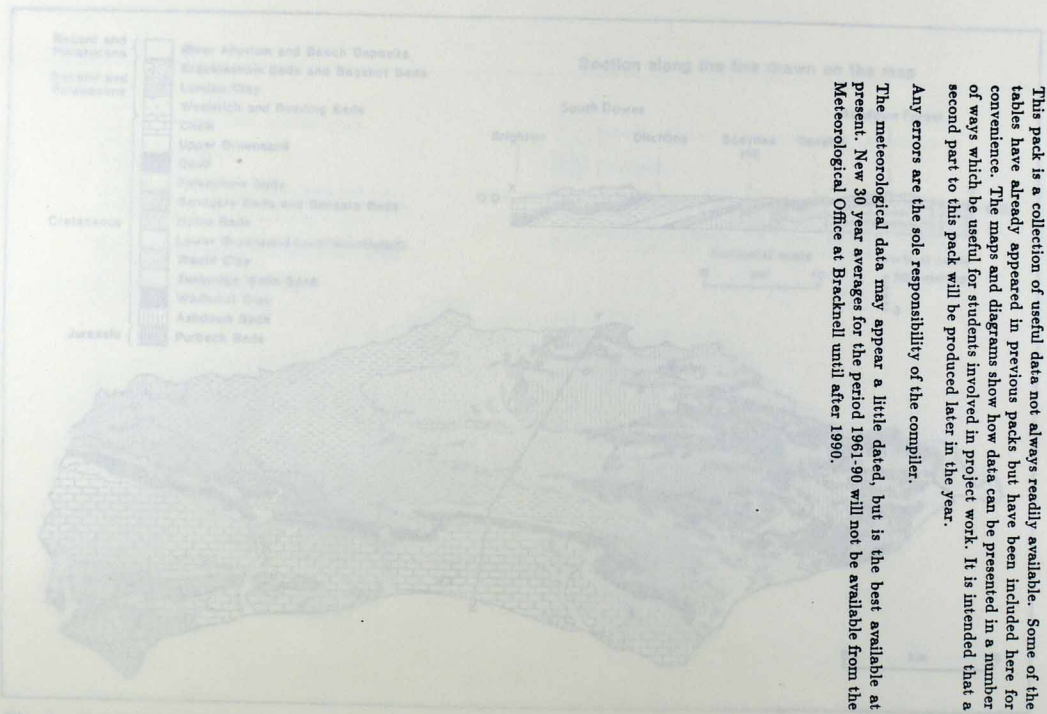


Fig. 1 - Geological Map of Surrey
